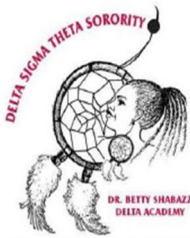

Delta Academy, GEMS and EMBODI Youth Initiatives Programs SAVE THE DATE

Solano Valley Alumnae (SVA), chartered in 1991 is a Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. an international not-for-profit public service organization. SVA provides its sorority's national Youth Initiatives Programs to youth in our community. A series of workshops will be held for middle school and high school youth on Tuesdays from 6:30 pm – 7:30 pm, starting October 13, 2020 and ending December 8 via Virtual Zoom sessions.

SVA youth programs and interactive activities are infused with curriculum materials based on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, & Medicine). The program's goals are to promote students' academic success, personal/ cultural development and wellness, and career/college readiness. The educational sessions are designed for: (a) middle school young ladies, *Delta Academy* ("Embracing Girl Power on Purpose"), (b) high school young ladies, *Delta GEMS* (JEWELS IN OUR GALAXY), and (c) middle and high school young men, *EMBODI* (Empowering Males to Build Opportunities for Developing Independence). The primary focus for the programs is to provide support to youth of color; however, all youth are welcomed and encouraged to participate.
